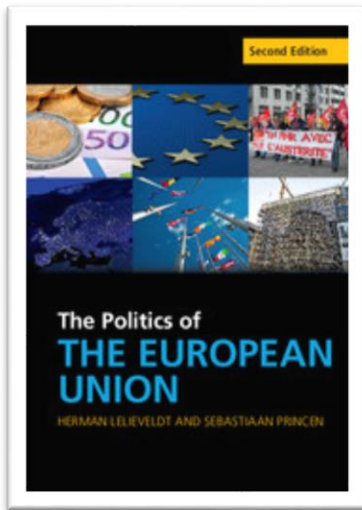




## Examples of how Academia uses VoteWatch data and expertise
